

Short Term Tender Notice.

Short term Sealed tender affixed with Rs (5) revenue stamp are invited for supply of wheat bran (choker) fine & wheat bran (coarse) ex factory from flour mills located at Khanna (Punjab) & other areas having capacity to produce 400-500 quintals per day. Wheat bran should have following parameters as per B.I.S.

1. Crude protein 13%
2. Crude fiber 12%
3. Fat 4%
4. Soluble Ash 0.75%.

The tenderers have to deposit an earnest money in shape of CDR/FDR amounting to Rs 1, 00000 (one lac only) pledged to Managing Director, J&K State AIDCL. The successful tenders have to produce security deposit of Rs 5, 00000 Lac (five lac only) in shape of Bank grantee & draw an agreement with Agro Industries Development Corporation Ltd. before allotment of work. The tender documents can be had from the office of Divisional Manager, J&K State AIDCL, House no. 7, Ramesh market, Shasti Nagar, Jammu against the cash payment of Rs 1000 by or before 7th September. Tender document can also be downloaded from our official website www.jkagro.com. The bidder has to submit demand draft drawn from J&K Bank Ltd. in favour of J&K State Agro Industries Development Corporation Ltd. payable at Jammu as cost of tender document & same may be submitted along with other tender documents, in case tender document is downloaded from website. The firm who will not submit tender document cast & earnest money their bid will not be accepted. The tender document will be available with our office up to 7th September. The last date for submission of tender is 9th of September 2017.

J & K State Agro Industries Development Corporation is a Organization fully owned by Government. The Organization deals in many activities out of which one of the activity is manufacturing of Cattle Feed at Bari Brahamana, Jammu and conducting sales through its dealer network spread throughout the State.

Now to cater to the demand of dealer and to provide them with Wheat Bran also Corporation proposes to procure it from reputed flour mills interested to supply this item to Corporation.

In the above back ground, Corporation seeks offers from interested flour mills for supply of Wheat Bran Fina quality and coarse variety as per BIS Standards

1. The offers should reach the office of General Manager, Jammu at the below mentioned address by or before 9th Sep. 2017 by hand, by registered post, by courier, affixed with revenue stamp of Rs. 5/- duly signed and stamped. Tenders brought by hand shall be put in tender box by the concerned tenderers on any working day during the office hours upto the said date and time. In case any Gazetted Holiday falling on the said date of receipt of tender or some holiday suddenly declared by the Competant Authority under negotiable instrument Act, the next working day shall be treated as last date of receipt of tender.

2. The tender should be accompanied with following documents;
- Security Deposit of Rs. 5,00,000 in the shape of Bank Guarantee pledged to M.O. JK AIOCL
 - Cost of tender document of Rs. 1000/2 in the shape of D. D. if downloaded from website or C. R. of the Corporation in case documents have been purchased from any of our offices (Jammu – Delhi – Srinagar) need to be attached with tender documents.
 - Certificate of registration of Flour Mill / firm dealing with Wheat Bran.
 - 500 gm sample of fine quality and coarse variety Wheat Bran each.
 - Capacity of the Wheat Bran production per annum.
 - Current market price list of the Wheat Bran.
 - The Tender documents duly signed with seal on each page in token of acceptance of all terms and conditions of Tender should also be enclosed.
 - Income tax and G.S.T. registration documents.

Note: In case the above mentioned documents are not enclosed the tender can be rejected as per the decision of the Purchase Committee.

- The rates quoted by the firm should be only for standard Wheat Bran. In case, the items do not qualify the requisite conditions, the rates shall not be considered.
- The firm shall have to certify that the rates quoted by them are the lowest rates and has not quoted rates lower than these rates to any Govt. Deptt. / Agency in J&K State for the similar items / Stores. If at any stage it is proved that the prices charged by tenderer are higher than the prices quoted to other Departments or higher than the prevailing market rates in our State, the tenderer shall be liable for

prosecution under law and the excess amount charged thereof shall be recovered from bill / securities etc of supplier.

3. The offers should be accompanied with a CDR for an amount of Rs. 1,00,000/- drawn from any scheduled bank and pledged to J&K State Agro Industries Development Corporation Ltd.
4. In case the firm fails to supply ordered items, within the stipulated period, the CDR shall be forfeited and supplier shall have no claim for its refund / release in any manner. Besides, the firm shall be black-listed for future business with JK AIDCL. Further if the Corporation has to purchase the material from L2 or from the market at the higher rates, the difference shall be recovered from the outstanding payment of the L1 (approved supplier) and for remaining amount suit for recovery shall be filed.
5. Conditional offers shall not be entertained.
6. The rates quoted by the tenderes should be ex works including loading charges & material shall be carried by the transport~~er~~ hired by the corporation.
7. Validity of Rates:- The rates quoted by the suppliers shall remain valid for three months from the date of acceptance of offers and thereafter shall be extended on mutual agreement.
8. Material before despatch shall be tested / checked by the Committee of officers of the Corporation at their stores before it is despatched to the Departments / Farmers / consignee etc. The Corporation shall also get the material tested on random basis out of each consignment to ensure that material supplied conforms to B.I.S. parameters.
9. Payments:
Payments shall be released on verification of the supplies and receipt of the same from indenting Departments.

10. Agreement:

The successful firms shall have to execute an agreement in the prescribed format within seven days from the date of intimation to this effect/placement of supply order.

11. Security Deposit

The successful supplier firm is required to deposit an amount of Rs. 5,00,000/- as Security Deposit in shape of CDR of any Scheduled Bank or Bank Guarantee of any Scheduled Bank within 7 days from the date of issue of order pledged to J & K State Agro Industries Dev. Corporation.

12. ARBITRATION

In case of dispute of any nature arising while servicing the ordered items, the matter shall be referred to the Managing Director, JK AIDCL whose decision as arbitrator shall be binding for the resolution of the dispute. In case the matter cannot be resolved further, in that situation, the legal institution / Courts of the J&K State shall be the alternative forum for dispute resolution.


13. Managing Director, AIDCL reserve the right to accept or reject any or all tenders in part or full without assigning any reason thereof.
14. As soon as the acceptance of tenders is conveyed to the successful firm the contract shall be final and binding upon the successful firm and agreement deed shall have to be executed with the Corporation by the supplier within 7 days from the date of issue of letter of acceptance.
15. The tenderer along with its offer must also submit a certified copy of its Income Tax, PAN and G.S.T. registration.
16. Tender without payment of tender cost shall be rejected.
17. The offer should be signed by the authorised person and his full name and status should be indicated below his signature.

18. The tender should be neatly written in ink with rates in figures & words. Cutting or over writing on quoted rates shall not be entertained unless authenticated Cello tape be applied of tender.
19. The supplier shall have to supply the Wheat Bran, 20 KG, 25 KG H.D.P. woven bags and as on when requirement in 20 KG, 25 KG Jute Bag duly printed.
20. The Bags shall be supplied by the Corporation against proper receipt and shall be kept by the supplier in safe custody to avoid its misuse with proper records of its consumption.
21. The cost of weighing, bagging and stitching of bags shall be borne by the supplier / tenderer.
22. The Tenderer while quoting their rates should mention their experience in the field and attach a list of parties whom they are regularly supply wheat bran.
23. The detail of specification of Wheat Bran (choker) has been explained in the tender published.
24. The quantity required shall be around 50,000 qtl. to 100,000 qtl and is tentative and shall depend upon market demand and position of funds.
25. The CDR of successful Tenderer shall be retained till the successful execution of supply and the CDR's in case of other shall be released subsequently.
26. Full payment shall be released within period of 20-30 days from the receipt of satisfactory test report from our quality control lab.
27. In the case of supplier fails to execute the supply in time the security amount shall be forfeited and the losses incurred shall be recovered from the suppliers.
28. Income Tax if applicable shall be deducted at source.

29. At the time of finalization of the offer the lowest bidder shall execute on agreement that he accepts the terms and conditions shown in the NIT. In the case where no offer is received the purchase committee shall be at liberty to arrange the material from manufacturers directly.
30. The Corporation reserves the right to carry out market survey also to arrive at the lowest market rates.
31. Cost of loading should be included in the offer.

32. Force Majeure:

If the completion of the supply is delayed by strikes lockouts fire accidents war or any other cause beyond the control of the supplier and the supplier satisfies the Corporation by a documentary proof in that respect, a reasonable extension in the time limit may be granted by the Corporation without effecting or decreasing/increasing the basic price as per force majeure clause of the agreement. However, damages caused due to strikes, rain or snow shall not constitute an act of God.
